The District provides for Extended Opportunity Programs and Services (EOPS) for students.

The program shall include the following components:

- Staffing and program management
- Documentation and data collection system
- An EOPS advisory committee
- A full time director
- Eligibility criteria
- Student responsibility requirements
- Recruitment and outreach services
- Cognitive and non-cognitive assessment, advising, orientation services and registration assistance
- Basic skills instruction, seminars, and tutorial assistance
- Counseling and retention services
- Career employment services
- Transfer services
- Direct aid
- Establishment of objectives to achieve the goals in implementing extended opportunity programs and services
- Review and evaluation of the programs and services and submission of related reports.
