- 4 Transcripts of <u>all</u> college level coursework (or official final high school transcript for incoming freshmen).
- 5 Additionally, the WHCL Office of Financial Aid must have the results of your submitted Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by the scholarship deadline.

Incomplete applications will NOT be reviewed. It is your responsibility to ensure that your file is complete.

The information contained within this application is true to the best of my knowledge. I understand that misrepresentation or fraudulent information may be grounds for loss of scholarship funds and/or required repayment.
